

Minutes of the Meeting held on 29th January 2020 at 1500 hrs at the Office Chamber of Additional Secretary, General Administration Department on the "Timeline to enable UPI, Dynamic UPI, QR Code, Debit Card (including Rupay), Credit Card (including Rupay) and Internet Banking for receiving payments in Govt. websites/ mobile apps".

He initiated discussions on the agenda of the Meeting which included the status of activities in connection with receipt of Government collections through GRAS and the timeline to enable UPI, Dynamic UPI, QR Code, Debit Card (including Rupay), Credit Card (including Rupay) and Internet Banking for receiving payments in Govt. websites/ mobile apps with reference to D.O. letter No.12(11)2017-DPD(Pt.3) dated 23rd April 2019 from Joint Secretary, MeitY.

After detailed discussions, the following decisions were taken:

1.	<p>It was stated by the GRAS Technical Team of NIC that Debit Card (Mastercard, Maestro, RuPay, SBI Maestro, VISA), Credit Card (Mastercard, VISA, American Express), Internet Banking (Catholic Syrian Bank, City Union Bank, DCB Bank, Federal Bank Ltd., Indus Ind. Bank, ING Vysya Bank, Jammu & Kashmir Bank, Karur Vysya Bank, Lakshmi Vilas Bank, Oriental Bank of Commerce, Punjab Sind Bank, South Indian Bank, Syndicate Bank, Tamilnad Mercantile Bank, United Bank of India, State Bank of Bikaner & Jaipur, State Bank of Mysore, State Bank of Travancore, UCO Bank) have been integrated with GRAS portal for ease of collection of Government revenue.</p> <p>Communication to the GRAS Team shall be done for integration of Credit Card (Rupay) and UPI/ Dynamic, UPI QR code with GRAS.</p>	General Administration Department
2.	<p>It was learnt that Assam House/ Bhawan New Delhi and Assam House/ Bhawan Chennai are making all Government collections through GRAS. As per Notification No ASPIRe/38/2017/372 dated 7th December 2018 of Finance Department, "SAD and GAD will have to mandatorily make all collections through GRAS portal only. The same will be rolled out to all departments facilitating collections and a formal launch will be done subsequently. Departments are hereby requested to provide necessary support to the GRAS technical team. Necessary capacity building and training will be provided by GRAS technical team".</p> <p>Therefore, communication shall be made with all Divisional Commissioners, Resident Commissioners/ concerned Officials of Assam Bhawans/Houses, Deputy Commissioners, Sub-Divisional Officers(c), Directorate of Sainik Welfare etc to make</p>	General Administration Department

	all Government collections through GRAS only and to nominate Officials for a training on GRAS (to be imparted by Finance Department).	
3.	Communication to all Divisional Commissioners, Deputy Commissioners, Sub-Divisional Officers(c), Directorate of Sainik Welfare, Assam Bhawans/Houses to share the necessary details for implementation of GRAS, with GAD for onward submission to the GRAS Technical Team. 4.	The PMO reference No. 5048482/2019-ES.I Dated 10-06-2019 and related Letters / enclosures shall be shared with all the stakeholders (GRAS technical team, Divisional Commissioners, Resident Commissioners/ concerned Officials of Assam Bhawans/Houses, Deputy Commissioners, Sub-Divisional Officers(c), Directorate of Sainik Welfare) for necessary action. 5.	The timeline to enable UPI, Dynamic UPI, QR Code, Debit Card (including Rupay), Credit Card (including Rupay) and Internet Banking for receiving payments in Govt. websites/ mobile apps shall be 4 (Four) months approximately.	GRAS Technical Team.


