OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub : Creation of Post of Bunglow Peon of Ministers.

In terms of provision under rule 5 (iv) of the Assam Ministers' (Ministers of State) and Deputy Ministers' (Allowances and Privileges) Rules, 1958, there is no provision for engagement of Bunglow Peon for the Ministers, Ministers of State and Deputy Ministers.

The Governor of Assam is after due consideration, pleased to decide that Chief Minister, Ministers, Ministers of State and Deputy Ministers are to be entitled to one Bunglow Peon each for discharging duties like attending telephone calls receiving and delivering daks, etc. in the residence of the Ministers, concerned.

The Peon shall be entitled to a consolidated salary of Rs. 750/- (Rupees Seven hundred fifty) only per month (all inclusive). He may be entertained by the Minister for the period for which the Minister remains in office from the date of entertainment and when the Minister vacates the office the services of the Peon so engaged shall stand terminated. The Minister entertaining the Peon may either appoint a peon of his choice or take a regular Peon from the Secretariat. Peon selected by the Minister should generally conform to the qualifications laid down for recruitment of Grade IV in the Secretariat. The appointment of the Peon shall be ad-hoc and his appointment shall not confer any right for regular appointment or absorption in the regular Grade IV Post. Such Bunglow Peons who have completed more than 5 years of continuous service in the Secretariat in the same procedure as laid down for the Bunglow Peon for officers in Finance Deptt's O.M. No. FEB.105, dtd. 16.12.83 read with Personnel (B) Deptt's O.M. No. A/113/90/2, dtd. 29.1.91. The Bunglow Peon shall borne outside regular cadre of Peons in the Secretariat and the expenditure on this account will be debitable to the head of account "201-SS-II-Other State Plan & Non-Plan Schemes-090- Sectt. (D) Deptt. of Personnel & A.R. (i) SAD-1-Salaries."

(b)

The Personnel, S.A. (Nazarat) Deptt. will create such Posts, as and when necessary.

The terms and conditions under which the appointment is to be made as detailed above should be strictly adhered to.
